Enrichment Classes at Northville First Care

We are gearing up for fall, and that means our fall 2014 enrichment classes will be available soon! These classes are open to some of our oldest classrooms and are all fun and educational. Watch for sign-up sheets to appear in your child's classroom.

Little Ninjas Karate: Mondays 10:00-10:30 am; \$65 for 12 weeks beginning 9/22 and ending 12/10. Taught by Greg Martin from PKSA Karate in Northville, this class is open to Early Preschool and Kindergarten Readiness students. (There is a 22 student limit.)

GYMM Class: (Gymnastics, Yoga, Movement and Music): Wednesdays 9:00-9:30 am, \$75 for 12 weeks beginning 9/22 and ending 12/10. Taught by Stephanie Seyfarth and Solange Kaschak, this class is open to Early Preschool and Kindergarten Readiness students. (There is an 18 student limit.)

Spanish Class: Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15-4:00 pm, \$150 for 12 weeks beginning 9/22 and ending 12/10. Taught by Amy Malhmeister, this class is open to Kindergarten Readiness students. (There is a 10 student limit.)
