Available to our Early Preschool, Preschool and Kindergarten Readiness classes

GYMM Class will resume on Wednesday, January 21st.

This special class includes Gymnastics, Yoga, Music and Movement will meet on Wednesdays from 9-9:30 am. This class was very popular in the fall and will be limited to 16 children. The twelve week session costs \$75 and proceeds from this program will be used to fund our scholarship program at NFC. Stephanie Seyfarth and Solange Kaschak will again teach this class and incorporate the motor skills needed to become strong and confident learners. Previous participants as well as new children are welcome.
