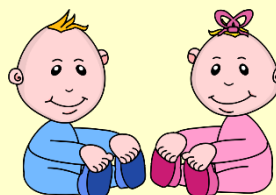

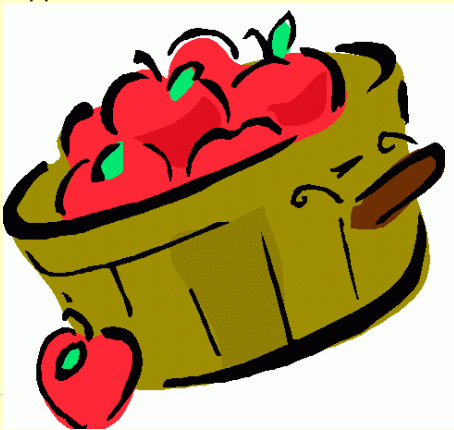

## Three Cedars Cider Mill Trip
